Deed Of Settlement and PSGE Ratification Poll 2013

FINAL RESULT

The results for the ratification poll held by internet, postal and ballot box voting at two information hui between Friday 27 April and Monday 27 May 2013 are:

Resolution 1: I, as a member of Ng ti Rangiteaorere, agree to accept the Ng ti Rangiteaorere Deed of Settlement.

The majority (being 67.60%) of valid votes cast on the resolution voted YES/ E.

I therefore declare that Resolution 1 is Accepted.

Resolution 2: I, as a member of Ng ti Rangiteaorere, agree that the Ng ti Rangiteaorere Koromatua Council will be the PSGE for the Ng ti Rangiteaorere historical Treaty of Waitangi settlement redress.

Resolution 3: I, as a member of Ng ti Rangiteaorere, support the proceeds of the 1993 settlement and the 2013 settlement being managed by the trustees of the Ng ti Rangiteaorere Koromatua Council.

The majority (being 65.63%) of valid votes cast on the resolution voted YES/ E.

I therefore declare that Resolution 3 is Accepted.

Resolution 4: I, as a member of Ng ti Rangiteaorere, support the use of the majority of available funds administered by the Ng ti Rangiteaorere Koromatua Council to purchase land in the area approximately bounded by Lake Rotokawau, Te Ngae Farm and the Lake Okataina Scenic Reserve.

The majority (being 65.16%) of valid votes cast on the resolution voted YES/ E.

I therefore declare that Resolution 4 is Accepted.

The voter return was 43.22%, being 360 votes cast from 833 eligible electors, of which 35.83% voted on the internet and 64.17% voted at the information hui or by post.
