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AUDITORS' REPORT

To the Committee of Management of NGATI RANGITEAORERE CLAIMS COMMITTEE.

We have audited the financial statements on pages 3 to 12. The financial statements provide information about the past financial performance of the NGATI RANGITEAORERE CLAIMS COMMITTEE, and its financial position as at 31 March 2010. This information is stated in accordance with the accounting policies set out on page 3 and 4.

Committees' Responsibilities

The Committee of Management is responsible for the preparation of the financial report which gives a true and fair view of the financial position of the NGATI RANGITEAORERE CLAIMS COMMITTEE as at 31 March 2010 and of the results of operations for the year ended on that date.

Auditors' Responsibilities

It is our responsibility to express an independent opinion on the financial report presented by the Committee of Management and report our opinion to you.

Basis of Opinion

An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence relevant to the amounts and disclosures in the financial report. It also includes assessing:

- The significant estimates and judgements made by the Committee of Management in the preparation of the financial report, and
- Whether the accounting policies are appropriate to the Claims Committee's circumstances, consistently applied and adequately disclosed.

We conducted our audit in accordance with New Zealand Auditing Standards. We planned and performed our audit so as to obtain all the information and explanations which we considered necessary in order to provide us with sufficient evidence to give reasonable assurance that the financial report is free from material misstatements, whether caused by fraud or error. In forming our opinion we also evaluated the overall adequacy of the presentation of information in the financial report.

Other than in our capacity as auditors we have no other relationship with or interest in Ngati Rangiteaorere Claims Committee.

Qualified Opinion

The Claims Committee's recorded income from OTS is \$556,000 and \$397,397 from CFRT. Of this income \$416,338 was unpaid to the Claims Committee at year end and has been accrued as an account receivable. Due to the processes demanded by OTS and by CFRT in determining when income is due, we have not been able to independently confirm the accuracy of this account receivable balance, or verify this balance to a subsequent receipt of funds.

In this respect alone, we have not obtained all the information and explanations that we have required.

In our opinion except for adjustments that might have been found to be necessary had we been able to obtain sufficient evidence concerning accounts receivable, the financial reports on pages 3 to 12 fairly reflects the financial position of the NGATI RANGITEAORERE CLAIMS COMMITTEE as at 31 March 2010 and the results of its operations for the year ended on that date.

Our audit was completed on 2 May, 2011 and our qualified opinion is expressed as at that date.

Note 1 STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Reporting Entity

Ngati Rangiteacrere Claims Committee is an unincorporated committee. The financial statements of the Committee have been prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting practice.

Measurement Base

The general accounting principles recognised as appropriate for the measurement and reporting of financial performance and financial position on a historical cost basis have been used. Accrual accounting is used to recognise expenses and revenues when they occur.

Nature of Business

The purpose of the Claims Committee is to progress Waitangi Treaty claims on behalf of Ngtai Rangiteaorere iwi.

Reporting Period

The reporting period for these financial statements is 16 months from December 2009 when the Claims Committee was established, until 31 March 2010.

CFRT Contract 1891

CFRT Contract 1891 is between the Crown Forestry Rental Trust and Te Maru o Ngati Rangiwewehi on behalf of Nga Punawai o Te Toku Toru. The Ngati Rangiteaorere Claims Committeee is a member of Nga Punawai o Te Toku Toru.

The total amount of Contract 1891 was for \$619,240, and of that amount the following amounts were allocated to Ngati Rangiteaorere Claims Committee;

Mandating \$163,770 Operations & Negotiations \$233,626

The Contract started on the 27th March 2009 and ended on 30 June 2009,

SPECIFIC ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The following specific accounting policies which materially affect the measurement of financial performance and financial position have been applied:

Accounts Receivable are stated at expected realisable value.

Goods and Service Tax

These Financial Statements have been prepared on a GST inclusive basis of accounting as the Claims Committee is not registered for GST.

Taxation

No provision has been made for any income tax that may be payable.

Grants Received from Crown Forestry Rental Trust have been accounted for in the period in which they are expended for the purpose for which they were received. Any balance of grants not received at balance date have been recorded as an account receivable in the Statement of Financial Position.

Differential Reporting

The Claims Committee is entitled to claim certain exemptions from reporting standards under the differential reporting framework by virtue of the following criteria:

- the Claims Committee does not have public accountability.
- the Claims Committee is not large.

The Claims Committee has taken advantage of the differential reporting exemptions available.

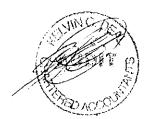
Note 5 CAPITAL COMMITMENTS
